Wash feet in warm water every day.

2



Dry your feet well, especially between the toes

3



Keep the skin soft
with a moisturizing lotion

Inspect your feet every day for cuts, bruises, blisters, or swelling.
Tell your doctor right away if you find something wrong.

5



Ask your diabetes care team how you should **care for your toenails.**

6



Wear clean, **soft socks** that fit you.

7



Keep your feet warm and dry. **Always wear shoes that fit well.**

8



Never walk barefoot indoors or outdoors.

9



Examine your shoes every day for cracks, pebbles, nails, or anything that could hurt your feet.

10

Diabetic shoes are known as extra depth, therapeutic shoes or Sugar Shoes.

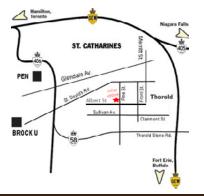
The specially designed shoes, or shoe inserts help reduce the risk of skin breakdown in diabetics with pre-existing foot disease.
